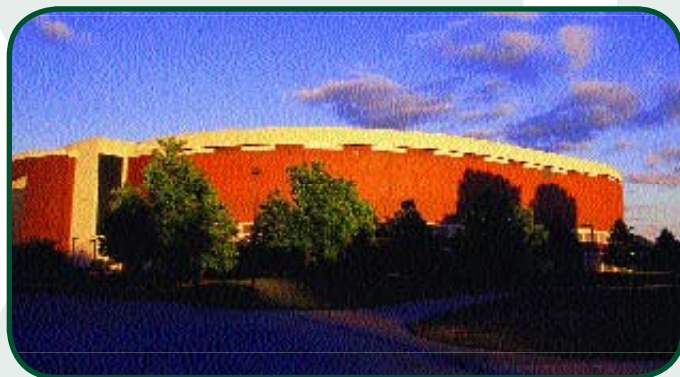

Mark Montgomery
Associate Head Coach

Associate Head coach, Mark Montgomery, returned to his alma mater in 2001 after four seasons on staff at Central Michigan. While at Central, he was instrumental in resurrecting the

Chippewa's program, culminating in 2001, with a 20-8 record and CMU's first M.A.C. championship, since 1987.

A native of Inkster, Michigan, 'Monty' was a four year starter for the Spartans from 1989-1992. He was a senior co-captain and a two-time Academic Big Ten Honoree. In his four seasons, the Spartans achieved a Big Ten Championship, one NIT and three NCAA appearances. After leading the Spartans in assists in both his junior and senior seasons, Monty still ranks fourth in career assists at MSU.

Coach Montgomery has a bachelor's degree in Business and following his days at MSU, he played four years professionally in Europe prior to beginning his coaching career at CMU.



Dwayne Stephens
Assistant Coach

Assistant coach, Dwayne Stephens, returned to his alma mater after six seasons, two at Oakland University, and the last four at Marquette University, where he was

very instrumental in the Eagles advancement to the 2003 Final Four.

Coach Stephens, a Ferndale, Michigan native, was a four year performer for the Spartans and in those four years, the Spartans were in post season play each and every year. In his four year career, Dwayne never missed a game and was chosen team MVP, as well as being a senior captain. At Michigan State, Coach Stephen's coach responsibilities include working with post players, scouting and recruiting duties.

Coach Stephens earned a bachelors degree in criminal justice from MSU in 1993. He then played professionally for 3 seasons in Europe prior to entering coaching at Oakland University.



Mike Garland
Assistant Coach

Assistant coach, Mike Garland previously spent seven years on the Spartan staff and was instrumental in helping produce four big ten titles and one national

championship. Prior to returning to MSU in June 2007, Coach Garland served three years as Head coach at Cleveland State and one year as Associate Head coach at SMU.

Coach Garland was also a very successful high school coach at Belleville High School, winning six conference titles and earning numerous coach of the year awards during his nine year tenure.

In 1977, Coach 'G' graduated from Northern Michigan University, where he and Coach Izzo were basketball teammates.

Coach Garland's family includes his wife Cynthia, daughter Simone, sons Quentin and Michael Ray, and grandchildren Simone, LaNyla and Jacqueline.

Head Coach (1995-present)

In his 14th year directing the Spartan program, head coach Tom Izzo has compiled an impressive list of accomplishments, including one NCAA National Championship, four regular-season Big Ten Championships, two Big Ten Tournament titles, four Final Four appearances, four National Coach of the Year awards and a Big Ten-best 11 straight NCAA Tournament appearances.

These accomplishments, however, are not what make Izzo one of the best in the Game, but rather it is his insatiable desire to accomplish more.

With a career record of 305-130, it's easy to see that Izzo knows how to win, but he also knows how to win the right way. In his 13 full years directing the Spartan program, 83 percent of his players who completed their eligibility also left with a degree. In the last nine years, 29 Spartans have received their undergraduate degrees, including five each in 2001, 2003 and 2007.

In 14 seasons, Izzo has returned Michigan State to national prominence, placed his name in the NCAA record books and become a leader among college basketball coaches.

Tom originally came to MSU from Northern Michigan, where he had been an assistant from 1979-83. An Iron Mountain native, he played guard for the NMU basketball team from 1973-77 and was voted the team's MVP as a senior. He also was a third-team Division II All-America pick that year, and established a school record for most minutes played in a season.

Izzo began his coaching career as head coach at Ishpeming High for the 1977-78 campaign. He served as an assistant at Northern Michigan from 1979-83 and then came to Michigan State as an assistant under Jud Heathcote.

Tom's family includes his wife, Lupe, daughter, Raquel and son, Steven.
