Soccer Camp Information

The program at the Michigan State University Soccer Camp concentrates on developing the soccer players' skills and experience. Every player will receive instruction on individual skills and techniques, as well as on individual, group and team tactics.

Players will be instructed by the Michigan State Men's and Women's coaching staff, as well as current varsity players. In addition, players will learn from top high school and college coaches representing both large and small institutions.

The facilities at Michigan State University are among the nations finest, including newly constructed DeMartin Stadium. Players will live and eat in a modern university dormitory hall where three excellent, well-balanced meals are served daily and prepared by the MSU Food Service Staff. Camp sessions will be held on Michigan State's varsity soccer fields. A swimming pool, gymnasium, tennis courts, racquetball courts, and other recreational features are also available to all players.

Age

The Spartan Soccer Camp is open to all boys and girls ages 10-18, for commuter participants and 12-18 for residential participants.

Camp Fee

- ▶ All campers, both resident and commuters, will receive a camp t-shirt and a soccer ball.
- ▶ Commuters are required to check-in Sunday afternoon during regular check-in. Breakfast is not included with commuter fee.

Elite Team Programs

In conjunction with the Spartan Soccer Camp, Michigan State University offers an elite team program. In addition to the individual technical and tactical instruction, a MSU staff coach will provide teams with tactical analysis and a team building offensive and defensive training session. Team coaches are welcome to attend and participate in the program. These coaches will receive discount room and board.

- ▶ This program is designed to benefit both club and high school teams.
- ▶ Team discounts – Ten or more members of the same team will receive \$25.00 off the per player camp fee. ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED IN THE SAME ENVELOPE.

Goalkeeper Plus Program

In conjunction with the Spartan Soccer Camp, Michigan State University offers a Goalkeeper Plus Program. This is a special daily training program designed exclusively for goalkeepers. MSU goalkeeper coaches John McElroy and Stacy Heller and other goalkeeper coaches will work with goalkeepers at each session.

All areas of advanced goalkeeper training are covered, including: shot saving, distribution, handling air balls, one-on-one play and controlling the penalty area.

Individual analysis is emphasized and each goalkeeper receives a written evaluation at the end of the week.

Register online at www.sportcamps.msu.edu or complete the attached application. Full payment by either check, MasterCard or VISA must accompany the application. Walk-In Registration Policy

Walk-in registration (signing up on the day camp begins) will be accepted on a space available, first come, first served basis. An additional \$10.00 fee will be charged for walk-in registrations. Please note that walk-ins are not guaranteed admission once a camp is full. Cash payment only. No checks or credit cards.

Refund Policy

Campers unable to attend camp are entitled to a refund. A \$55 administrative fee will be deducted from all refunds, regardless of the reason. Refund requests must be submitted in writing PRIOR to the first day of the camp session in which the camper was originally enrolled.
