Wilson Hall is conveniently located south of the Breslin Center and can accommodate your team and coaches in suite-style residence hall double rooms (two double occupancy bedrooms sharing one bathroom).

Teams will be housed with players in one area and coaches in another within the hall.

REGISTRATION TO PLAY

REGISTRATION TO STAY

Cost is **\$20.50** per person, plus a 6% use tax. Payment by Credit or Debit Cards ONLY. Refunds will not be granted after June 9th.

The deadline to register is June 9th to guarantee housing. Walk-in teams may not receive on campus housing.

CHECK-IN & CHECK-OUT

Teams may check-in at East Wilson Lounge any time from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm on Friday, June 16th. If your team will be checking in after 4:00 pm, please notify the East Wilson Service Center at (517) 353-2902 between 11:00 am and 5:00 pm on June 19th.

Teams must check out of East Wilson Hall before **noon on Saturday, June 17th**. Upon check-out, anyone who does not turn in their room key and building will be charged \$75.

SERVICES

Wilson Hall. Check the reception desk
for local vendors.

SECURITY

For the safety of your team, the residence hall will be locked at 10:00 pm. Coaches must notify the Community Directors staff by calling (517) 353-4313 to notify them of any athletes who will not be in the hall by 10:00 pm. All players arriving to the hall after 10:00 must be accompanied by a coach.

Participants are expected to follow all MSU ordinances and Residence Hall regulations and that if participants violate any of these policies the may be asked to leave the Residence Hall.
